



#### **Language for Success Digital Tool Kit**

Another exciting resource CCLB/CNCLC is working on to support language and the topic of employment is our Language for Success digital tool kit. This tool kit, funded by the Government of Canada's Adult Learning, Literacy and Essential Skills Program, will support the integration of Skills for Success in second or other language training. The tool kit components are based on a newly developed Language for Success Framework that uses the CLB/NCLC to showcase the language needs within the Skills for Success.
